RECIPE OF THE MONTH

February 22 is National Chili Day!

One-Pot Chili Mac

Ingredients:

- 1 tablespoon vegetable oil
- 2 medium onions, diced
- 8 ounces ground beef (80/20 or leaner)
- 2 teaspoons taco seasoning mix
- 28 ounce can crushed tomatoes
- 1 & 1/2 cups broth
- 8 ounces dried elbow macaroni (enriched or WGR)
- 15.5 ounce can kidney beans, drained and rinsed
- 1/2 cup milk
- 6 ounces (1 & 1/2 cups) shredded cheese

Instructions:

1. Heat the oil in a 3 & 1/2- to 4-quart pot over medium-high heat until simmering.
2. Add the onion and cook until light golden-brown, about 5 minutes.
3. Add the ground beef, break into smaller pieces with a wooden spoon or spatula, and cook for about 3 minutes.
4. Add the seasoning and cook for another minute.
5. Pour in the tomatoes, broth, macaroni, and beans.
6. Bring to a boil, then reduce heat to medium-low.
7. Simmer uncovered, stirring occasionally, until the macaroni is tender, about 15 minutes.
8. Stir in the milk and cheese until melted.
