

RECIPE OF THE MONTH



No-Bake Strawberry Blueberry Trifle

INGREDIENTS

- 17 oz angel food cake, cut into 1" cubes
- 1 lb fresh strawberries, hulled and sliced
- 1 lb fresh blueberries
- 4 or 5 qt trifle dish

Lemon Syrup Ingredients:

- 1/4 cup water
- 2 Tbsp sugar
- 2 Tbsp lemon juice, from 1/2 medium lemon

Frosting Ingredients:

- 8 oz each cream cheese softened at room temp
- 3/4 cup granulated sugar
- 2 cups heavy whipping cream
- 1/2 tsp vanilla extract

INSTRUCTIONS

How to Make Lemon Syrup:

1. In a measuring cup, combine 1/4 cup water, 2 Tbsp sugar and 2 Tbsp lemon juice and stir until sugar is dissolved. Set aside until needed.

How to Make the Trifle Cream:

1. Beat together 1 lb cream cheese and 3/4 cup sugar (with the whisk attachment) on medium speed until creamy and smooth, scraping the bowl a couple times. With mixer on, pour in 2 cups heavy cream then turn mixer to medium/high and continue beating until until whipped and fluffy. Add 1/2 tsp vanilla and beat until incorporated.

Assembling the Berry Trifle:

1. Place 1/3 of your sliced angel food cake into the bottom of your trifle dish and brush with 1/3 of your syrup. Add 1/3 of your cream and loosely spread it over cake pieces. Add 1/2 of the sliced strawberries. Repeat with remaining ingredients (adding 1/2 of the blueberries for the second fruit layer). Frost the top with last 1/3 of cream and decorate with remaining fruit.

Don't Be a Money Mule

A money mule moves illegal money - money that comes from illegal or fraudulent activities - on someone else's behalf. Some money mules know they are transporting illegal funds and others are employed innocently or with false promises of easy payment.

Types of Money Mules

- Unwitting or Unknowing: Individuals are unaware they are part of a larger scheme
- Witting: Individuals ignore obvious red flags or act willfully blind to their money movement activity
- Complicit: Individuals are aware of their role and actively participate
