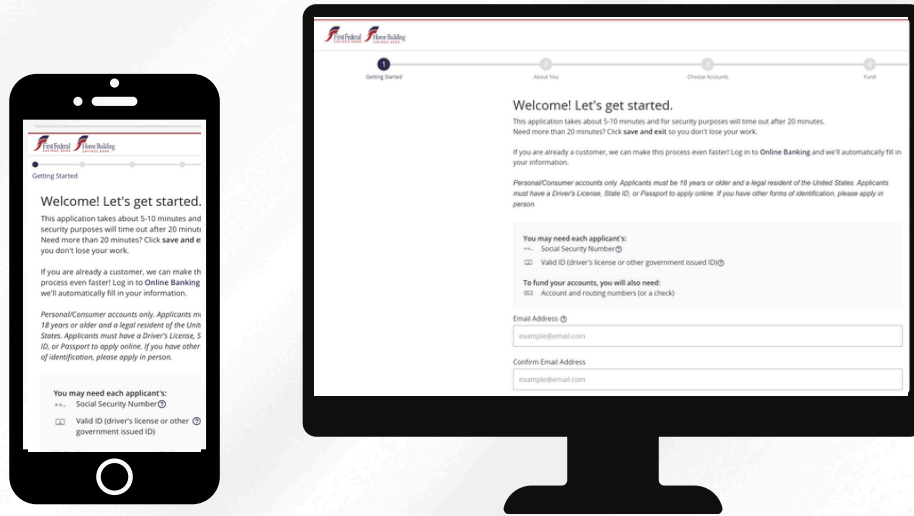

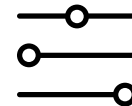

# RECIPE OF THE MONTH



## Cajun Chicken Pasta

### INGREDIENTS

- 8 oz. bow tie pasta
- 3 tbsp. unsalted butter
- 1 1/2 tsp. minced garlic
- 2-3 chicken breasts, cut into chunks
- 3 tsp. Cajun seasoning, more or less to taste
- 4 oz. cream cheese, softened
- 1 cup milk
- 3/4 cup freshly grated parmesan cheese
- 1/2 tsp. black pepper
- 1/2 tsp. salt
- 1 red bell pepper, cut into slices
- 1 yellow bell pepper, cut into slices

### INSTRUCTIONS

1. Cook pasta according to package directions until al dente. Drain, rinse with cold water, and set aside.
2. In a large skillet, melt butter over medium heat. Add minced garlic and cook for 30 seconds.
3. Add cubed chicken, red and yellow bell peppers, Cajun seasoning, salt, and pepper. Cook for 4-5 minutes or until chicken is no longer pink inside.
4. Add milk and softened cream cheese and stir until the cream cheese is melted and the sauce is creamy.
5. Add cooked pasta noodles and parmesan cheese. Stir to combine ingredients well. Serve with garlic bread or a green salad. Enjoy!

## SECURITY CORNER

### ATM Skimming

Tips when using an ATM or POS terminal, including for EBT:

- Inspect ATMs, POS terminals, and other card readers before using. Look for anything loose, crooked, damaged, or scratched. Don't use card readers if you notice anything unusual.
- Cover the keypad as fully as possible when you enter your PIN to prevent cameras from recording your entry.
- If possible, use ATMs in a well-lit, indoor location.
- Be especially alert for skimming devices in tourist areas.
- When possible, use your debit card's chip technology.
- Routinely monitor your bank account to promptly identify any unauthorized transactions.
- Setup real-time alerts through our online banking/mobile app to notify you of the activity you set. It's quick, easy, and can significantly reduce the risk of financial losses.
- Contact First Federal Savings Bank immediately if the ATM doesn't return your card after you end or cancel a transaction. This may suggest the presence of a foreign device in the card reader.
