RECIPE OF THE MONTH

Lasagna Soup

INGREDIENTS

- 1-2 tablespoons olive oil
- 1 pound ground beef
- 1 large diced onion
- 4 cloves minced garlic
- 1 (15-ounce can) diced tomatoes (don't drain)
- 1 (15-ounce can) tomato sauce or tomato puree
- 3 ounces tomato paste
- 4 cups chicken broth
- 1-2 cups water (more as needed to adjust consistency)
- 1 tablespoon Italian seasoning
- 1 teaspoon sea salt (more as needed to adjust flavor)
- Black pepper, to taste
- 8 ounces bowtie pasta (uncooked)

INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Heat 4.5 quart soup pot over medium-high heat. Add olive oil and heat until simmering.
- 2. Add ground beef, onions, and garlic. Sauté until the beef is cooked through, stirring as needed. Drain excess fat, if needed.
- 3. Stir in tomatoes (with their juice), tomato sauce, tomato paste, broth, Italian seasoning, salt, pepper, and pasta noodles.
- 4. Increase heat to high and bring the soup to a boil.
- 5. Reduce heat to a medium simmer and cook soup for 10 to 15 minutes until the pasta is cooked to your liking, stirring frequently to prevent the pasta from sticking together.
- Note: If needed, add more water or broth in small amounts to adjust the soup consistency to your liking.
- Serving options: 1) Add the ricotta, mozzarella, and/or parmesan to the whole soup; or 2) Serve the cheeses on the side and add it to individual servings. Garnish with fresh parsley.

With Zelle®, you can send money from your account to someone else within minutes. It's a great way to pay friends, family, your coworkers and almost anyone else you trust, but it shouldn't be used to pay strangers.

Zelle® doesn't offer a protection program for authorized payments, so only use Zelle® to pay people you know and trust.

Treat Zelle® Like Cash

Money moves fast directly into the enrolled recipient's bank account. Always double check you have the recipient's correct U.S. mobile number or email address, so the money goes to the right person.
