How Scammers Try To Steal Your Life Savings

People are losing big money to scammers running complicated scams.

Here's how the scam works:



A scammer pretending to be from a company you know contacts you saying they supposedly spotted fraud on one of your accounts and your money isn't safe.

They connect you with someone else to supposedly help you move your money to "protect" it.

The "helper"— who often claims to work for the government — is really a scammer trying to steal your money.

If someone tells you to do any of these things, it's a scam.

"Put your money in a secure account to protect it." That's a scam. "Transfer your money to a cryptocurrency account to protect it." That's a scam.

"Get cash and I'll send a driver to pick it up." That's a scam. "Deposit cash at a Bitcoin ATM to protect your money." That's a scam. "Buy gold and a driver will come get it." **That's a scam.**

No one from the government will tell you to do these things. Only a scammer will.

Never transfer or send money, cryptocurrency, cash, or gold to someone you don't know in response to an unexpected call or message.


Your tax forms, including Forms 1099 and 1098, are now available in eStatements.

RECIPE OF THE MONTH

February 27 is National Chili Day! Best Chili Recipe.

INGREDIENTS

- 2 pounds lean ground beef
- 1 onion diced
- 1 jalapeño seeded and finely diced
- 4 cloves garlic minced
- 2 ½ tablespoons chili powder divided, or to taste
- 1 teaspoon cumin
- 1 green bell pepper seeded and diced
- 14.5 ounces crushed tomatoes
- 19 ounces canned red kidney beans drained and rinsed
- 14.5 ounces canned diced tomatoes with juices
- 1½ cups beef broth
- 1 cup beer
- 1 tablespoon tomato paste
- 1 tablespoon brown sugar (optional)
- Salt and black pepper to taste

INSTRUCTIONS

- Combine ground beef and 1½ tablespoons chili powder.
- In a large pot, brown ground beef, onion, jalapeno, and garlic. Drain any fat.
- Add in remaining ingredients and bring to a boil. Reduce heat and simmer uncovered 45-60 minutes or until chili has reached desired thickness.
- Top with cheddar cheese, green onions, cilantro or other favorite toppings.
